Vision

The Marcola School District promotes academic excellence, ethical and responsible citizenship for all its students in a safe, supportive, and enriched learning environment.

A big Thank You to Adrienne for spending the weekend working on the Charter School Implementation grant that was due Sunday at midnight. We spent most of Friday and Saturday writing and crunching numbers with our grant writer, and as I am writing this “Week at a Glance”, I think the grant is finished and ready to submit. Also - a big thank you to Phil for providing all the information needed to complete the grant. This grant could bring up to \$450,000 for implementation costs of TNW. So, how does this benefit Marcola School District? See Below:

1. For every elementary student enrolled in TNW, MSD receives 20% of the ADM revenue. If TNW enrolls 200 elementary students, MSD receives \$312,000. For every high school student TNW enrolls, MSD receives 5% of the ADM revenue. If TNW enrolls 75 High School Students, TNW receives \$29,250.00.
2. TNW is a partner with Marcola School District and operates under a mutually agreed upon Charter School Contract that will be official on July 1, 2019. Currently, TNW is a MSD virtual alternative program. Even though, TNW has a huge waiting list, MSD students have priority for enrollment and will not be put on a waiting list.
3. TNW provides credit recovery courses and a wide variety of virtual courses for MSD students who either need credit recovery or want to take a course we do not offer.
4. TNW’s Professional Development Plan includes training for virtual delivery of content. MSD employees are welcome to attend at no charge.
5. MSD employees and staff are always considered for temporary or permanent hire when TNW positions are open. TNW encourages MSD teachers to consider paid opportunities for mentoring/tutoring TNW students.
6. Most importantly - TNW is providing an excellent alternative program for numerous students in Oregon.

I only offer this explanation to help people understand the benefits of supporting/authorizing a charter school that can offer students (including our students) alternative choices for an education. Marcola School District and TEACH Northwest are partners and work together in the best interest of all the students we serve.
