- ❖ Governor Brown has opened the door for a return to more In-Person instruction for Oregon schools.

What does *RETURN* mean?

- On March 1st, Mohawk HS Students will be able to return to the classroom in a Hybrid model
- Students will remain in their current instructional pods
- We take the first step towards a more traditional school experience for students

HYBRID?

Each instructional pod will receive 2 days of in-person instruction on campus, and 2 days of comprehensive distance learning in a [hybrid schedule](#)

When will we be *SET?*



- The state has set [164 requirements](#) that must be implemented for students to return to the building
- The building needs to be prepared to provide a safe environment for students
- The staff has to receive the mandatory training so that they all understand the new protocols that staff, students, and the community have to follow
- MSD reopening plan is based on [State Metrics](#)
